

Leadership Excellence Program



Collective Foundation has entered into a partnership with Monash Business School and its Corporate Education arm to establish the Future Hospitality Academy – a dedicated centre of excellence to support the long-term sustainability of Australia’s hospitality industry.

The inaugural course is the Leadership Excellence Program - a practical, industry-focused development program which will be delivered via half-day face to face learning blocks across 12 consecutive weeks.

Leadership Excellence Program

The program has been designed by hospitality professionals and leadership experts to be highly applicable to leaders working in hospitality businesses today. The key principles of the program development are:

- **Applied learning:** Immediate workplace relevance
- **Industry contextualisation:** Hospitality-specific scenarios
- **Practice-based delivery:** Role plays, simulations, case studies
- **Business impact:** Work-based project aligned to organisational priorities

WHO IS IT FOR?

The course is designed to support foundational leadership skills for current and emerging leaders.

Successful participants must be working in a hospitality leadership role with at least two years' experience in management.

PROGRAM COST

The development of the Academy, management of the application process and all course content has been directly funded by Collective Foundation.

Course delivery fees and enrolment is directly with Monash Corporate Education's program and is \$3,500 per participant.



Program Structure

Facilitator Mode

The program is delivered by experienced Monash facilitators with expertise in leadership, hospitality operations, and organisational performance. The program will also draw on practitioners from industry and guest speakers from outside of hospitality.

Facilitators bring a combination of academic rigour and industry experience, ensuring learning is both evidence-based and highly practical.

Capstone Project (Week 12)

Participants will complete a work-based project aligned to a problem statement agreed with C-suite (or equivalent) leaders.
